

## Acceptable Pieces of Identification

An Applicant must provide two (2) **valid** pieces of identification: A **PRIMARY** card and a **SECONDARY** card.

<u>PRIMARY pieces of ID</u>	<u>SECONDARY pieces of ID</u>
<p>Any <b>government-issued</b> card that includes the <b>Applicant's name, date of birth, signature and photo.</b></p> <p><b>Some examples:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Driver's License (issued by Canadian province or territory)</li> <li>▪ Foreign Driver's License</li> <li>▪ Canadian Passport</li> <li>▪ Foreign Passport</li> <li>▪ BC Driver's Licence and Services Card</li> <li>▪ Photo BC Services Card</li> <li>▪ Permanent Resident (PR) Card</li> <li>▪ Canadian Citizenship Card</li> <li>▪ Secure Certificate of Indian Status Card</li> <li>▪ Canadian National Institute of The Blind (CNIB) Identification Card</li> <li>▪ Federal, Provincial or Municipal Identification Card</li> <li>▪ Military Family Card</li> <li>▪ Firearms Acquisition Certificate (FAC) or Possession/Acquisition License (PAL)</li> <li>▪ Provincial or Territorial Health Cards <sup>(1)</sup></li> </ul>	<p>Any other "<b>PRIMARY</b>" piece of ID from the left column. or A piece of identification from the list below (Applicant's name on ID below must be the same as the name indicated on "Primary" ID)</p> <p><b>Examples of "SECONDARY" pieces of ID:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Government Employment Card</li> <li>▪ International Student Card</li> <li>▪ Age of Majority Card</li> <li>▪ Birth Certificate</li> <li>▪ Baptismal Certificate</li> <li>▪ Non-Photo BC Services Card</li> <li>▪ Hunting License</li> <li>▪ Fishing License</li> <li>▪ Boating License</li> <li>▪ LCBO/Age of Majority Card</li> <li>▪ Outdoors Card</li> <li>▪ Hospital Card</li> <li>▪ Canadian Blood Donor Card</li> <li>▪ Immigration Papers</li> <li>▪ Student ID</li> <li>▪ City/Municipal Library Card</li> <li>▪ Utility bill (water, electricity, taxes or Lease agreement showing both name <u>and</u> address will be accepted - to be used <u>only</u> in cases where the Applicant does not have a Secondary piece of ID).</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>Will NOT be accepted:</u></b></p> <p><b>Some examples:</b> Non-Government Employment Card, Social Insurance Number (SIN) card, Credit/Debit Card, Gym member Card, Costco Card, Air Miles Card, etc.</p>	

<sup>(1)</sup> **Provincial or Territorial Health Card as Primary ID or Secondary ID:** as permitted to be used for identification purposes under provincial law. Government-issued Health card that includes the Applicant's name, date of birth, signature and photo will be accepted if the Applicant volunteers to submit his/her Health Card as a piece of identity **and** the photocopy of the Health Card number is blacked out before submitting for a criminal background check.
